## SOFTBALL

The Varsity Softball team had its best season in five years, doubling their total wins and scoring twice as many runs as last season. ## SWIMMING

The Varsity and JV Swim teams had strong seasons, highlighted by the JV Mission League Championship. The JV defeated Harvard Westlake 81-80 for the key victory in the title drive. The Varsity competed well at Mission League Finals: Jessica Schem '09 swam a CIF Consideration Time in the 100 Breaststroke; Diamond Romano '09 and Krissa Gosnell '08 finished strong in the 100 Free Style; Carolina Davidson '10 swam well in the 50 and 200 Free Style. The Royals also received strong performances from Brittany Bin '09, Amber Heitkemper '09 and Elisabeth Leoni '08.

The Track and Field team had another outstanding season with strong finishes in invitational meets, the Mission League and CIF. This season the Royals broke school records in Shot Put and Triple Jump. # CIF-SS Academic Awards Program

Perseverance, self-discipline, focus and goal-setting are just some of the characteristics that the student athletes of Louisville High School take from the athletic arena to the classroom. These characteristics make Louisville's athletes not just formidable academic opponents in the Mission League, but in the CIF-SS as well.

For the second year in a row, seven of Louisville's eleven CIF-SS teams achieved top-ten rankings in the CIF-Southern Section Academic Awards Program. The Louisville Golf team, achieving the highest average GPA among all girls golf teams in CIF-SS with an enrollment under 1,500, was honored at a pre-game ceremony at an Angels baseball game at Angel Stadium. This is the second time in three years that Louisville's Golf team has achieved this highest academic award. In addition, the Cross Country team ranked 2nd and the Soccer Team ranked 3rd in the CIF-SS Academic Award Program.

Five other teams at Louisville High School ranked high in the academic competition as well, including the Softball team (6th), Tennis and Basketball teams (7th), Track team (9th) and Water Polo team (12th). Overall, seven of Louisville's teams ranked 1st among the Mission League schools and all Catholic high schools in the CIF-SS Academic Awards Program.

These student athletes have been great ambassadors for Louisville in both the athletic and academic realm. Louisville High School is proud of its student athletes for their hard work and dedication.
