

### **Louisville stuns sellout Texas Relays crowd in Austin, Texas**

In an impressive performance at the 82nd Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays in Austin, the Louisville Royals brought home their 2nd Longhorn Trophy in three years in the 4x400 meter relay finishing with a time of 4:00.22. The team of junior Natalia Williams, sophomore La Toya Williams, junior Monica Santos and sophomore Zoe Tucker came from behind with a blistering third leg from Monica Santos (58.8) giving Louisville a lead that they would not relinquish. Zoe Tucker extended the lead in the anchor leg with a 59.6 split, before a sellout crowd of 22,000 Texas track fans, who watched amazed as the Royals ran over the top teams from Texas.

### **Three Mission League Titles for Louisville Royals**

At the Mission League Finals at Valley College, the Louisville Royals brought home three Mission League Titles. Sophomore La Toya Williams became a two-time Mission League Champion in both of her races with personal bests in the 100m (12.18) and the 200m (24.88). The other Mission League title came from the 4x400 meter relay team of junior Natalia Williams, sophomore La Toya Williams, junior Monica Santos and sophomore Sara Ryan who won with a time of 4:05. In other events at the Mission League championships, several Royals qualified for the CIF Southern Section championships. In the 800 meters Natalia Williams finished 2nd with a time of 2:25.21. Sophomore Tuesday Walker finished 2nd in the Long Jump with a leap of 16'9". The 4x100 relay team of sophomore La Toya Williams, sophomore Tuesday Walker, junior Monica Santos and sophomore Sara Ryan finished in 3rd place with a time of 50.21 seconds. Sophomore high jumper Katie Barber also qualified with a leap of 5'1".

### **Royals Perform Well at CIF Division 4 Finals With Seasonal Bests**

The Louisville Royals performed well at the CIF Division 4 Track Finals at Cerritos College. The 4x100 Relay team of sophomores La Toya Williams, Tuesday Walker, Zoe Tucker and junior Monica Santos ran a seasonal best of 48.76 finishing 4th in what track experts say was the fastest small school 4x100 in history. National track powerhouses St. Mary's, Serra and Paraclete finished ahead of the Royals with top national times. La Toya Williams finished in a personal best of 12.04 in the 100m, and 24.93 in the 200m. Sophomore Katie Barber finished with a personal best of 5'2" in the high jump. The 4x400 meter relay team of junior Natalia Williams, La Toya Williams, Monica Santos and Zoe Tucker ran a seasonal best of 3:57.98.
